



Scholar Technology Agreement

To support online-based remote learning, Persistence Preparatory Academy Charter School is loaning Chromebook/BAK Tablets during the COVID-19 school building closure.

By consenting to this document, students and parents agree to abide by the following:

1. This laptop is to be used only by the student listed above for educational purposes, as assigned by Persistence Prep. It should not, under any circumstances, be used for:

- a) Non-Educational Games
- b) YouTube (unless videos posted on the **Joelle Formato** channel)
- c) Cheating or plagiarism of any kind
- d) Social Media (including Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Tik Tok, Snapchat, etc.)
- e) Communication via email, chat, video, or apps with anyone outside of Persistence Preparatory or other students, unless assigned.
- f) Inappropriate or adult content

2. Google should only be used by the assigned student and passwords must be safe-guarded. Students are responsible for all actions conducted under their accounts.

3. Chromebooks/Bak tablets are already equipped with all necessary applications and programs. No other applications, programs, extensions, or tools may be downloaded.

4. Labels or serial numbers should not be tampered, removed, or altered in any way.

5. Security methods, filters, and protections set in place by Persistence Prep should not be hacked, compromised, or altered in any way.

6. Persistence Prep reserves the right to monitor or review any information, documents, data, and communications that are accessed, stored, or transmitted on Chromebooks/Bak tablets. Students should have no expectation of privacy while in use of these devices.

7. Through daily monitoring, if it is found that a student violated any of the expectations listed above, their parent may be directly contacted by The Director of Operations to ensure closer supervision.

8. All technical difficulties, log-in issues, or damages must be reported immediately to Ms. Adria Sortino at (716) 308-6673.

9. Laptops and chargers must be returned in the same condition as it was loaned immediately upon reopening. If either item is damaged, lost, stolen, or significantly altered in any way, families are fully responsible for costs incurred for repair or replacement.
